2. Right to life & safety

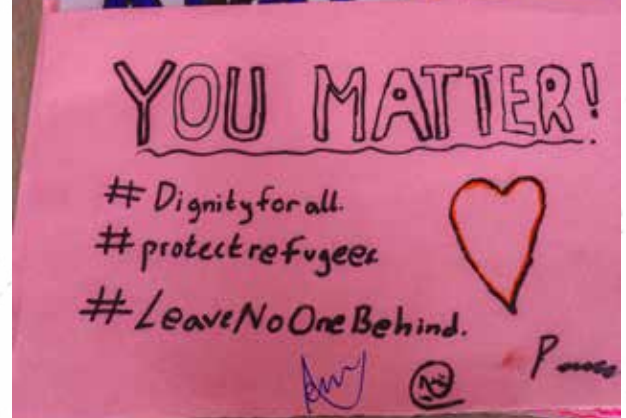
- This is <sup>your</sup> ~~the~~ right to live and be safe

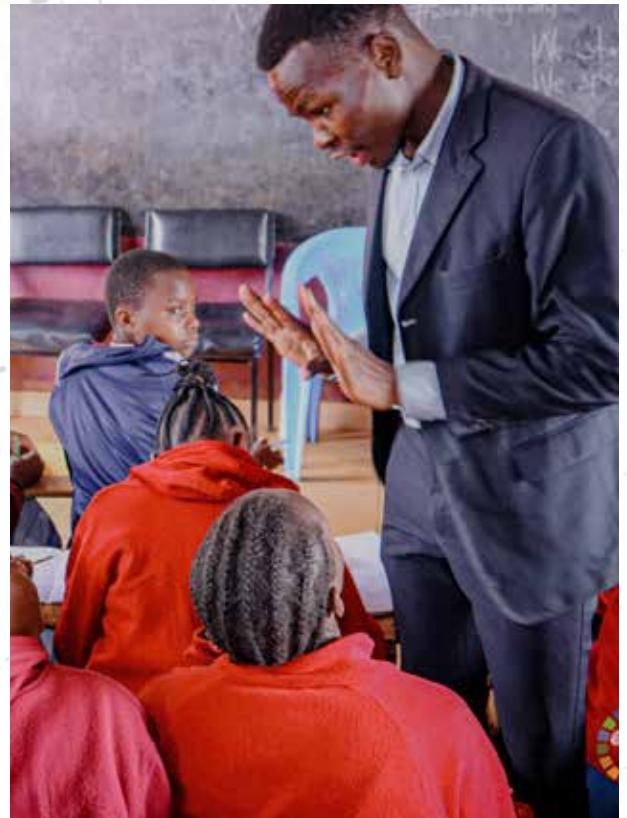

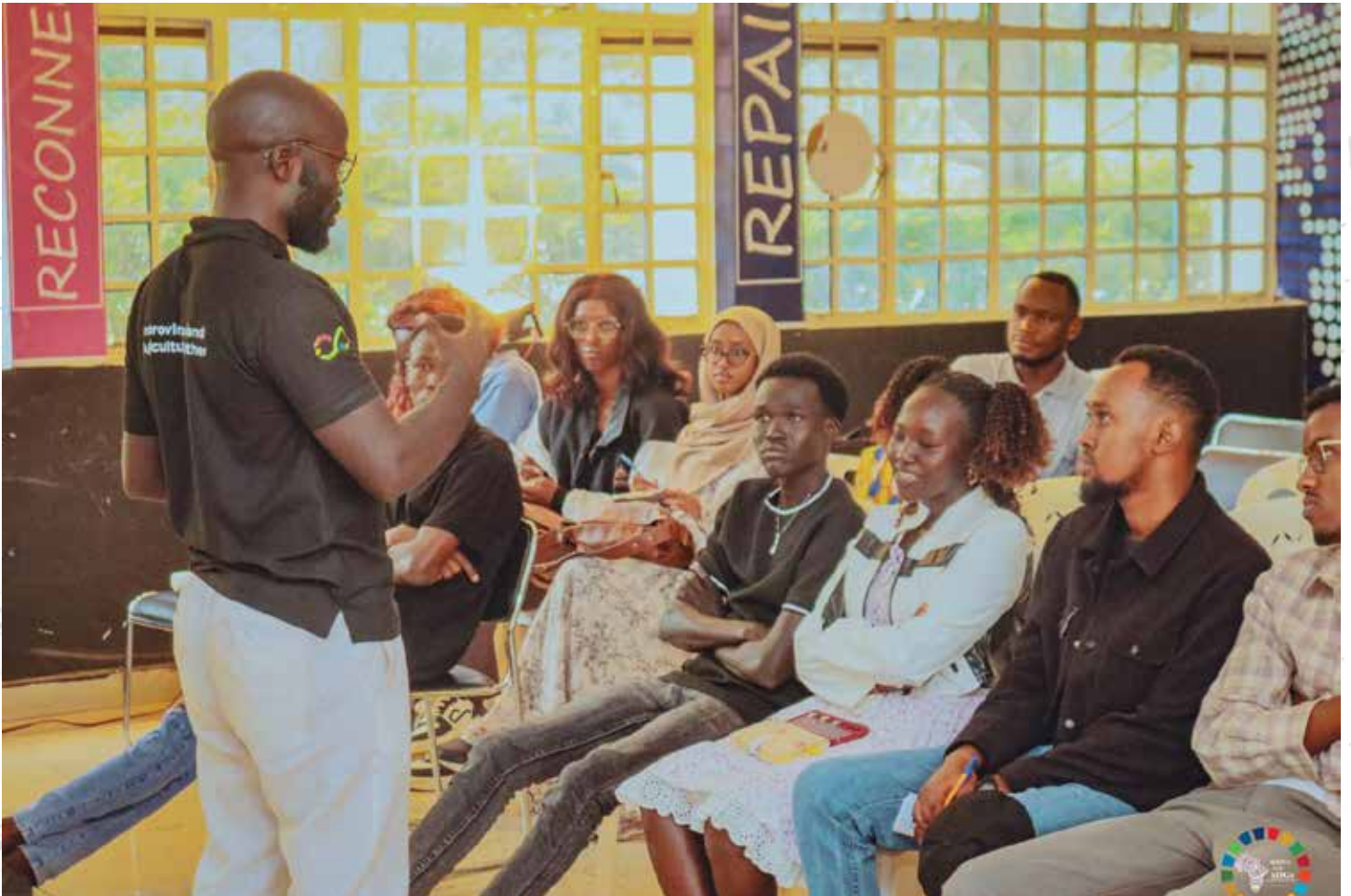

The session challenged the common approach of critiquing knowledge, instead urging us to build upon it and channel curiosity into tangible solutions that address gaps in food systems. We focused on the bigger picture of systemic change in food production, value chains, and entrepreneurship, moving beyond individual skills.

A key takeaway for young innovators was the importance of embracing risk and leveraging existing resources. Impactful change-makers, we highlighted, ask: "What resources do I have? What do I need? What outcome do I want to achieve?"











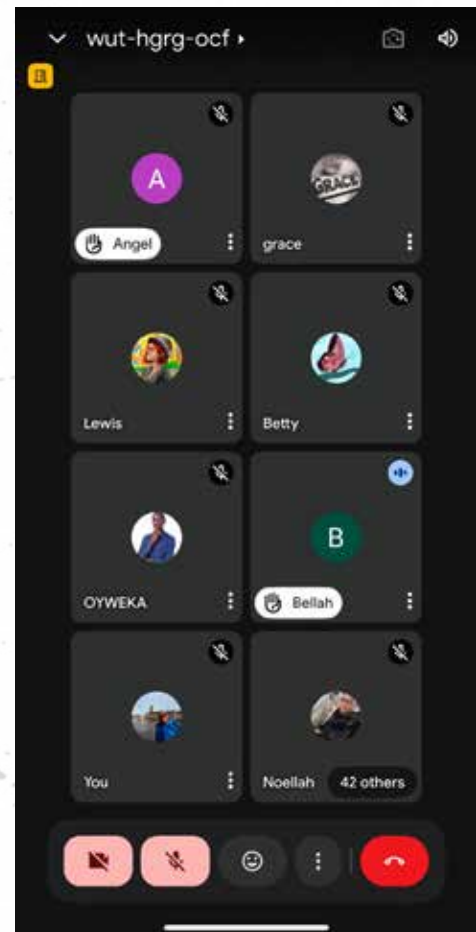
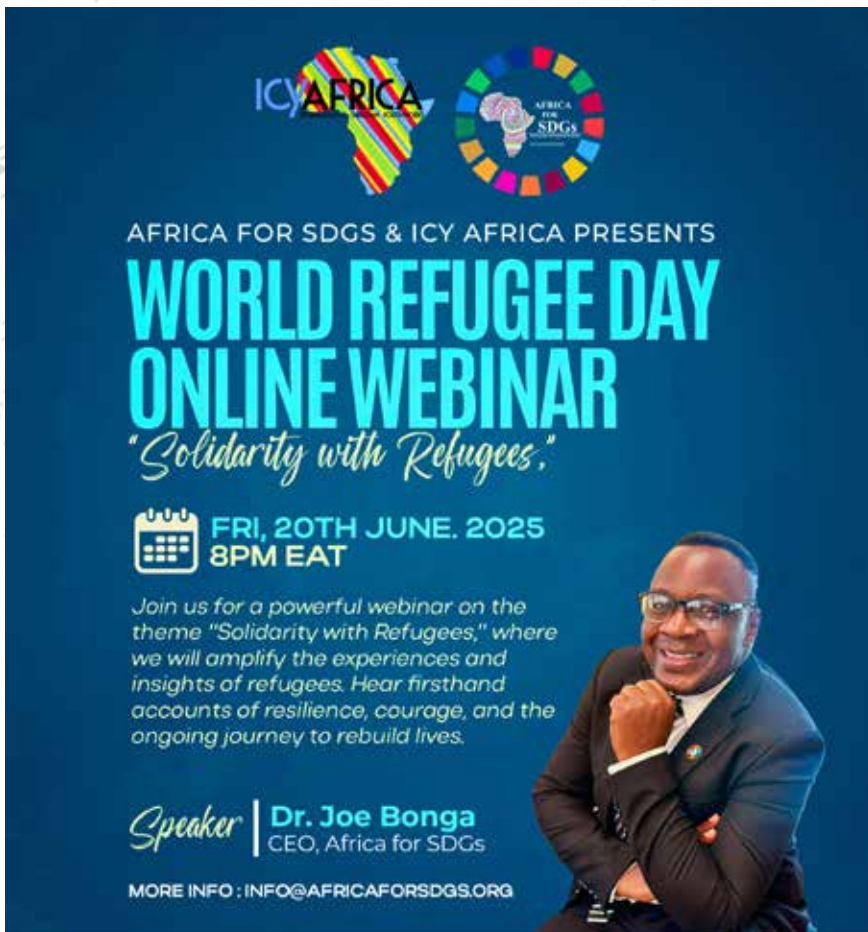
# WORLD REFUGEE DAY: A MEANINGFUL WEBINAR DISCUSSION!
